6. PATIENT SERVICES

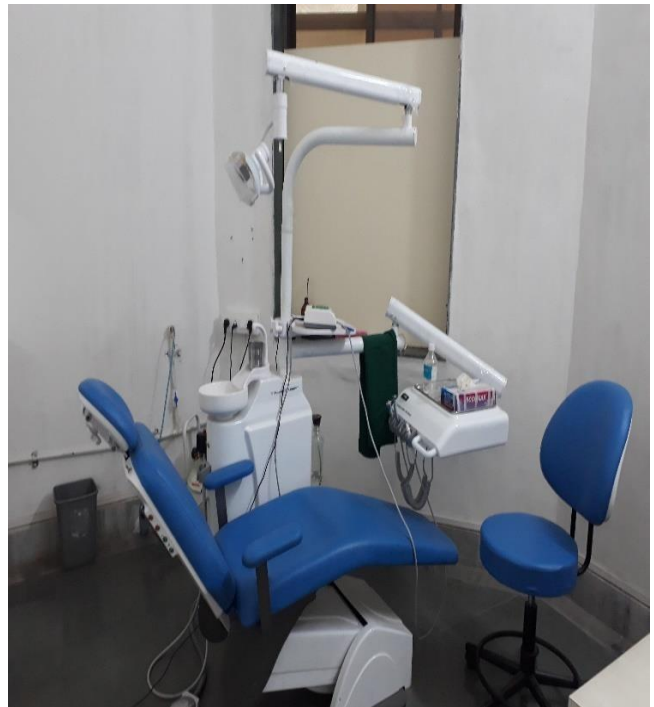
- Well-equipped OPD and IPD services for the patients.
